

German-Malaysian relocation team

International, flexible and on schedule: This sums up SCHOLPP's relocation project for Hamberger Industrierwerke, a specialist in wood processing based in Stephanskirchen. At its site in Hörselberg in Thuringia, a team of fitters from Germany and Malaysia had four weeks to dismantle several machines, transport them to Bavaria and reassemble them there. Our Malaysian colleagues were brought in to assist as part of our internal knowledge transfer programme.

Twelve complex machines from a production line for room acoustics elements had to be electrically and mechanically dismantled, packed, transported and reassembled. This included drilling machines, turning/milling machines, veneer-gluing machines and wood presses. The job had to be completed within four weeks.

On-the-job training: Fitters from Germany and Malaysia

The project manager overseeing the relocation put together an international team. What made this team special was that it included nine colleagues from Malaysia who had come to Germany to familiarise themselves with wood technology. In Asia, there is growing demand for services for the wood packaging industry. It therefore made sense to train our Malaysian colleagues on the Hamberger project.

The largest machines to be relocated were drilling centres. Due to their length of 13.0 metres and width of 2.5 metres, the centres were transported on a 4-axle low-loader. The journey required official authorisation as a heavy goods transport.

Punctual recommissioning

The German-Malaysian team also saw to the mechanical reassembly and electrical installation at the destination site. Our customers benefit in the long term from such transfers of machine-specific knowledge and the resulting flexibility in our workforce.

After twelve days, the challenge of reassembling everything on schedule had been overcome. Our customer Hamberger was able to recommission its wood processing line on the agreed date.
